As a HIPAA compliant entity, YuJa has the capacity to engage as a Business Associate under a HIPAA Business Associate Agreement (BAA). This is a contract between a HIPAA covered entity and a HIPAA Business Associate (BA) in accordance with HIPAA guidelines.
